Carpenter Foreman Primary Responsibilities and Essential Functions:

- Accurately report all job site time and activity daily review operations and all job site crews, subcontractors, materials, and equipment providers.

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- Monitor and ensure all safety systems and practices are in place and being followed.
- Understand project documents such as drawings, specifications, and any changes to the construction design. Identify and communicate all work outside of project scope with company superintendent.
- Monitor how the wind, or cold affect the curing of concrete throughout entire process and plan the concrete placement accordingly to produce a quality product.
- Keep job site, trucks, equipment clean and organized.
- Conduct work with 100% integrity and professionalism.
- May be required to perform task from other job descriptions depending on available work and schedules, I.e., wall/foundation building, form setter, earthworks, etc.

Required Skills, Abilities and Knowledge:

- High driven personality focusing on getting jobs done, being flexible, and being fully present at work.
- Knowledge of building construction means and methods, scheduling and cost control procedures, general contract, general conditions, subcontract documents, drawings and specifications.
- Knowledge of equipment selection- Determining the appropriate tools needed to do a job.



- Knowledge of hand-held and power tools including power screeds, troweling machines, cutting saws, and edging tools.
- Knowledge of skid steer, tele-handler, excavator operations preferred but not required.
- Knowledge and understanding of concrete mix design.
- Ability to use mathematics to problem solve.
- Ability to read drawings, plans and blueprints and convey this information to others.
- Ability to Initiate teamwork and be a team leader.
- Ability to give full attention to what others are saying, take time to understand, and ask questions when appropriate to comprehend and listen effectively in order to ultimately initiate teamwork.
- The ability to teach others effectively.
- Ability to perform the essential job functions consistently, safely, and successfully while meeting qualitative and/or quantitative productivity standards.
- Ability to maintain regular, punctual and consistent attendance.
